Travel continental U.S. to/from Hawaii valid Dec. 29, 2020, through April 8, 2021. Travel to/from San Juan, Puerto Rico valid Jan. 11, 2021, through April 11, 2021. International travel valid Jan. 11, 2021, through April 11, 2021. Continental U.S. to Hawaii blacked out Feb. 11, 2021, through Feb. 14, 2021; March 19, 2021, through March 20, 2021; March 26, 2021, through March 28, 2021; and April 1, 2021, through April 3, 2021. Continental U.S. from Hawaii blacked out Dec. 29, 2020, through Jan. 4, 2021; Feb. 19, 2021, through Feb. 21, 2021; March 27, 2021, through March 28, 2021; and April 2,

2021, through April 5, 2021. Except as otherwise specified, continental U.S. travel is not valid on Fridays and Sundays. Travel to Ft. Myers/Naples, Ft. Failure to cancel prior to departure will result in forfeiture of remaining funds on the reservation. Any change in itinerary may result in an increase in fare. Standby travel may require an upgrade to the Anytime fare depending on Rapid Rewards® tier status. Fares are subject to change until ticketed. Offer applies only to published, scheduled service.
