

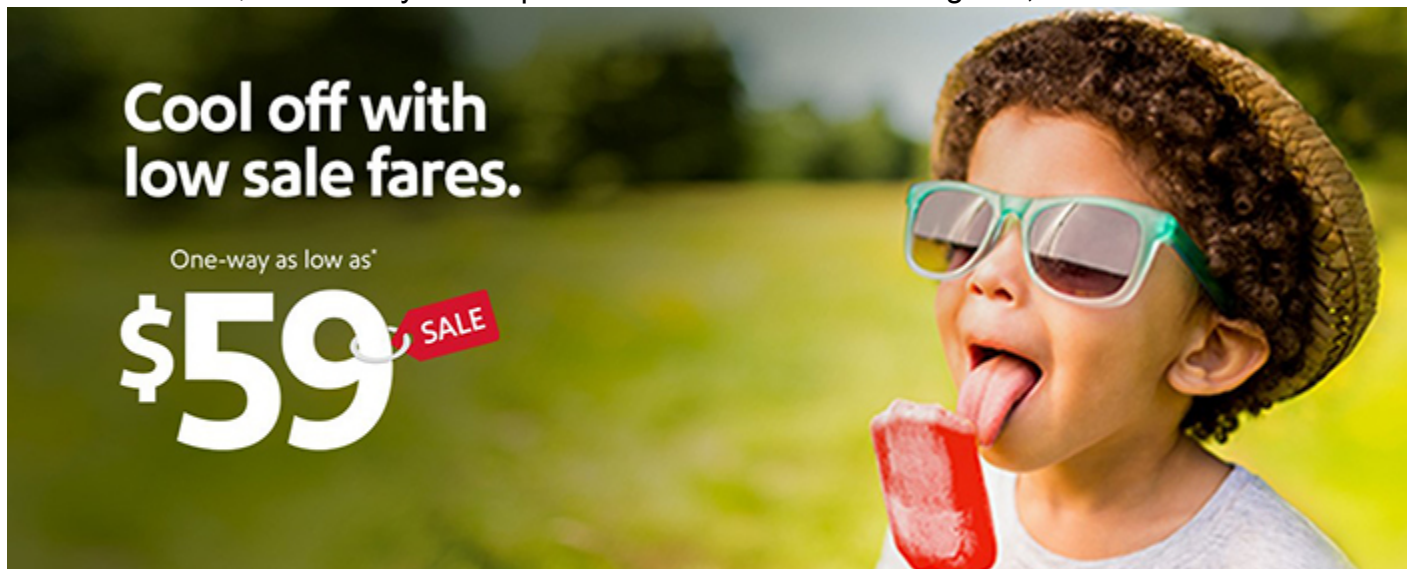
Southwest Airlines offers a summer sale with fares as low as \$59 one-way



Purchase from July 13, 2021, through July 15, 2021, 11:59 p.m. Central Daylight Time. Continental U.S. travel is valid Aug. 17, 2021, through Dec. 16, 2021. Travel to the continental U.S. to/from Hawaii is valid Aug. 9, 2021, through Dec. 15, 2021. Interisland Hawaii travel is valid Aug. 17, 2021, through Dec. 16, 2021. Travel to/from San Juan, Puerto Rico is valid Aug. 17, 2021, through Dec. 2, 2021. International travel is valid Aug. 17, 2021, through Dec. 8, 2021. Continental U.S. travel is blacked out Sept. 3, 2021; Sept. 6, 2021; Nov. 19, 2021; Nov. 23, 2021, through Nov. 24, 2021; and Nov. 27, 2021, through Nov. 29, 2021. Hawaii to the continental U.S. is blacked out Aug. 9, 2021, through Aug. 15, 2021. Travel the continental U.S. to Hawaii is blacked out Nov. 18, 2021, through Nov. 21, 2021. Travel the continental U.S. from Hawaii is blacked out Nov. 26, 2021, through Nov. 30, 2021. Except as otherwise specified, continental U.S. travel is valid only on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. Travel continental U.S. to/from Hawaii is valid only on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. Interisland Hawaii travel is valid only on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. Travel to/from San Juan, Puerto Rico is valid only on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. International travel is valid only on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. Travel to Mexico is valid only on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. Travel from Mexico is valid only on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. Fares are nonrefundable but may be applied toward future travel on Southwest Airlines, as long as reservations are canceled at least 10 minutes prior to the scheduled departure. Failure to cancel prior to departure will result in forfeiture of remaining funds on the reservation. Any change in itinerary may result in an increase in fare. Standby travel may require an upgrade to the Anytime fare depending on Rapid Rewards tier status. Fares are subject to change until ticketed. Offer applies only to published, scheduled service.

In its 51st year of service, Dallas-based [Southwest Airlines Co.](#) continues to differentiate itself from other air carriers with exemplary Customer Service delivered by more than 56,000 Employees to a Customer base that topped 130 million Passengers in 2019. Southwest has a robust network of point-to-point service with a strong presence across top leisure and business markets. In peak travel seasons during 2019, Southwest operated more than 4,000 weekday departures among a network of 101 destinations in the United States and 10 additional countries. In 2020, the carrier added service to Hilo, Hawaii; Cozumel, Mexico; Miami; Palm Springs, Calif.; Steamboat Springs; and Montrose (Telluride), Colo. Thus far in 2021, Southwest has initiated service to Chicago (O'Hare) and Sarasota/Bradenton both on Feb. 14; Savannah/Hilton Head and Colorado Springs both on March 11; Houston (Bush) and Santa Barbara, Calif. both on April 12; Fresno, Calif. on April 25; Destin/Fort Walton Beach on May 6; Myrtle Beach, S.C. on May 23; Bozeman, Mont. on May 27; and Jackson, Miss. on June 6; and will begin service to Eugene, Ore. on Aug. 29; Bellingham, Wash. on Nov. 7; and Syracuse on Nov. 14.

The carrier issued its [Southwest@Promise](#) in May 2020 to highlight new and round-the-clock efforts to support its Customers and Employees well-being and comfort. Among the changes are enhanced cleaning efforts at airports and onboard aircraft, along with a federal mandate requiring every person to wear a mask at all times throughout each flight.
